Removed

Members should only be "removed" from church membership in two situations, **church discipline** (aka "apostasy") and **personal request**. In both cases, the final decision needs to be made at a business meeting and not by the church board alone.

To enter this in eAdventist:

- 1 Find the member's record
- 2 Click the "Change Status" button
- 3 Set "Change to" to "Removed", enter the vote date and click the "Save" button.

Church Discipline

A member should only be "removed" for discipline after making every possible effort to win them. The church board needs to review the case. However, the final decision needs to be made by a majority vote taken at a business meeting presided over by a pastor or, in the pastor's absence, an elder.

Personal Request

Members who request to be "removed" should be given ample time and every effort made to restore them. The member should provide a letter of resignation to the church board, which will forward them to a business meeting. Out of respect for the individuals, the business meeting should vote to accept the resignation without public discussion. The church should notify the person of the action in writing. Where possible, this should be delivered in person by the pastor or person designated by the board.
